 where my Father now lies and the same Tract that was willed to my mother and her heirs
 by John T. Button of Charleston South Carolina Situated in the District and State aforesaid
 on the North side of Reedy River on Maple Creek a waters of said River adjoining
 lands of John Foster Lewis Rodgers, Anderson Bray, Barnett Smith and others
 As I have now arrived at lawful age I do grant sell and release all my right
 title and interest as an heir and legatee of my Mother Baylor Potts to whom said tract was
 willed as above stated to the said David Hooke his heirs Administrators Executors and assigns
 and I also release to the said David Hooke all the right title or interest that I have in the
 distribution share of said Land or undivided share of Allen Potts, from whom I purchased
