Heoke have granted the bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said D. Heoke his heirs and assigns all that plantation and Tract of Land that I purchased from the heirs of Shadrack Roberts at public outcry, lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid about four miles from Greenville Court House near Paris and Piney Mountain being the same tract wherein Shadrack Roberts lived and died, adjoining Lands of William Roberts, Parker Son with William Rains the same lying on Sangster's Branch waters of Ruddy River Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident appertaining
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
