

Hecke in the sum of One hundred and fifty Five Dollars and twenty five cents in and by a certain note of hand writing bearing date the 3 rd Sept 1849 payable to the said Q. Hecke at Twelve months after date Now know all men by these presents that I the said W. H. Roberts in order the better to secure the payment of the said sum of money and the interest that may accrue thereon and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid by the said Q. Hecke Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Q. Hecke his Heirs and assigns; all that plantation and Tract of Land that I purchased from the Heirs of Shuro Roberts at public outcry, lying and being in the District of Guerrille and State aforesaid about four miles from Guerrille Court House near Paris and Piney Mountains being the same tract whereon Shuro Roberts lived and died, adjoining Lands of William Roberts, Robert Southwell William Rainey the same lying on Sangston branch waters of Ruddy River Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident appertaining
