land Beginning on a Rock on the North side of said Mountain in a plat and
running North 114 Poles crossing Langston Branch by a W.C Station at 46 Poles to
an old chestnut and four small chestnuts 7 1/2 in the South line of said old Tract Thence
N 69 E 35 poles to a small chestnut oak near the road above James Roberts Carr
Thence S 57 E 74 poles to a small Black Gum and chestnut 7 1/2. Thence S 24 W 44
Poles to a Hickory near a part 7 1/2 Thence S 60 W 87 Poles to the beginning Containing
Forty Eight Acres Together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances
whosoever belonging in anywise appertaining thereto
