I know all men by these presents that I Squire Morgan

of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Josiah Wilgore all that Tract or parcel of Land containing One Hundred and eighty one acres situated in Greenville District South Carolina on Enore River and Buck Head Creek which land was conveyed to him by John and Patience Myers Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging and any issue incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Josiah Wilgore his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exec and Admin to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Josiah Wilgore his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person a person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

we Thomas P Brockman and Lawrence Lenhardt of the State and District aforesaid that for and in consideration to us in hand of the sum of One Thousand and Sixty one dollars paid by James A. Cotrell of Newberry District and State aforesaid That we have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, release and relinquish unto the said James A. Cotrell all that Tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville on both sides of the Buncombe Road known as the Gilmath place which land was set as the property of J. B. P. Hammell by Wm. Mc Gooch tell then Sheriff of Greenville District which includes all the land within the bounds of the following courses and distances except Nine acres lying immediately in the South corner between the Buncombe Road and the road to Greenville & the which will now fully appear by reference to a deed of J. B. P. Hammell to Hyde and from Hyde to Brockman Beginning as represented by Stake attached to the Grant on a Stake corner 3x on Stake line and running N 58 E 72 rods by a pine stump to a small Blk Oak 3x also marked on Waresworth original line then N 56 W 109 50 running close upon point
