This Indenture made the Eighteen day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Forty nine and in the Seventy fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America between Thomas Goldsmith of said State and District of the one part and William Goldsmith of same State and District of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Goldsmith for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Eighty Dollars Five Mollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain, sell and release and confirm unto the said William Goldsmith all that good a parcel of Land containing Five Hundred and Forty one Acres of Land by a survey in January 1836 Situated in said District on Murbergs Creek of Moore River and hath such bounds marks &c as follows (viz) Beginning at a Gum 37 in Durbens Creek Thence up said creek to a corner Thence S 25 W 16 chs to a Stake 37 Thence N 37 W 29 50 chs to a Chestnut 37 Chesh Thence S 45 W 3 50 chs to a Stone 37 Thence S 79 E. 9. 25 chs to a R0 37 Thence S 53 E. 3 65 chs to a Sassafras 37 Thence S 78 E 9 chs to a Sassafras 37 Thence N 10 W 8. 93 chs to a Chestnut 90 37 Thence N 18 E 8. 25 chs to a Sassafras 37 Thence N 75. W 15 chs to a Hickory 37 Thence N 33 W 61. 33 chs to a Stake Thence 49 E 38. 90. to a B Jack 37 dead Thence S 40 E. 3. 75 chs to a Stake 37 Thence N 51 E 37. 50 chs to a pine 37 Thence N 38 E. 42 50 chs to a Stake 37 Thence S 50 W 35. 50 chs to a Stake 37 Thence S 38 1/2 E 38. 50 chs to a Stone 37 Thence S 20 1/2 W 47. 50 to the beginning corner to include five hundred and forty one acres of Land as above mentioned and the said Thomas Goldsmith doth covenant and agree that he will forever warrant and defend the above described Five Hundred and Forty one acres of Land with all its appurtenances Hereditaments Emoluments Commodities Advantages Priviledges Rents Issues and Profits thereunto belonging as in any appurtenance thereunto or any part thereof from himself his heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever laying any just or lawful right Title or claim thereunto or any part thereof but to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Goldsmith his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever In Witness whereof the said Thomas Goldsmith hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and date just above written
