paid by Samuel Rains a free colored man of the same State and District have  
Grant's Bargain'd, sold and released and by these presents do Grant Rains sell and  
release unto the said Samuel Rains a certain Tract or parcel of Land Situated in the  
District and State aforesaid on Cain Creek Branch waters of Currier River containing  
Twenty Eight Acres the same being part of a Tract of Land formerly owned by William  
Taylor and conveyed by him to James Stuke a colored man and by the said Stuke  
to myself beginning at a Spanish Corner 37x37 cm and running S 1/2 W 38.70 ch to  
a P.C. 37x37 cm thence N 68 1/2 W 12.70 ch to a P.C. 37x37 cm thence N 20 1/2 E 30 ch  
to a Black Sackhead run thence N 33 1/2 W 14.05 to Dudley Kennells line thence  
S. 83. C. 9.00 to the beginning Together with all and singular their rights, members, heirs,  
tenants and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise in anywise  
appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
to the said Samuel Rains his heirs and assigns I do hereby bind myself my heirs exe-  
cutors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises  
unto the said Rains his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other  
person or person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
