Know ye that in consideration of your integrity and shall full power is hereby given to you a any two or more of you to take the relinquishment of Elizabeth Hawkins wife of Joseph Hawkins of Crawford County of Missouri of her estate interest and inheritance in the premises described in the annexed writ of Executions and Oliver P. Phillips of Greenville District State of South Carolina dated 12<sup>th</sup> January 1850 conveying the interest of her husband Joseph C. Hawkins and herself in a Tract of Land Situate in Greenville District State of South Carolina Containing Six Hundred and twenty two Acres more or less And for this purpose you will cause the said Elizabeth Hawkins to appear before you and you will examine her severally and separately apart from all other persons and if upon such examination she shall freely declare that she did at least seven days before such examination actually join her husband in executing the writ of release aforesaid that the said release was positively and bona fide executed at least seven days before such her examination and that she did then at the execution of the said release and still does at the time of examination freely voluntarily and without any manner of compulsion declare a fear of any person or persons whatsoever renounce release and freely relinquish all her estate interest and inheritance in the premises mentioned and conveyed in the said release into the said Oliver P. Phillips and his heirs and assigns

That you shall take under her hand a certificate of her renunciation and relinquishment as aforesaid in the form of a Declaration upon separate examination as aforesaid which certificate authenticated by your hands and seals you shall annex to this writ And you are also hereby fully empowered to take oaths of the execution of the said Decree and for this purpose you shall cause one of the subscribing witnesses of the said Decree to appear before you and having administered to him as you are fully authorized to do and oath a solemn affirmation according to the form of his religious persuasion that his affidavit is true you shall take under his hand and affidavit that he was personally present and saw Joseph C. Hawkins and Elizabeth Hawkins his wife sign said and deliver the Decree aforesaid for the use and purpose therein expressed and that he and the other subscribing witnesses signed their names thereto as witnesses of its due execution which affidavit authenticated under your hands and seals you shall annex to this writ And having certified under your hands and seals the due execution of this writ and
