or less Bounded by Lands of O. B. Irvine and the said E. T. Bust and having such
forms bounds and buttings as are set forth in a plat thereof made by W. P. Moore
W. S. and certified 2^d March 1847 (The said Land having been bargain sold and
delivered by the said Edward Craft to the said E. T. Bust and conveyed by a deed
bearing date 4th March 1847 having but one witness and being therein defective this
Deed is executed to remedy said defect

Herediments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging in any wise
incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before
mentioned unto the said E. T. Bust his heirs and Assigns forever And I do hereby
