I William Bramlett of the District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph McMillan of the State and District aforesaid have granted sold and released unto the said Joseph McMillan all that Tract or parcels of Land lying in the District aforesaid on the South side of South Tugue River Beginning on a line not on a branch or said McMillan line running N 75 E to the River or a well Thence down the said River to a Walnut on said Bramlett's line Thence along said line to a Stake Thence to a Post oak stump on said McMillan line Thence to the beginning corner Containing one hundred and twenty eight acres more or less

Together with the all and singular the wites messuages tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging to or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises hereafter mentioned unto the said Joseph McMillan his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McMillan his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against all other persons As Witness my hand and seal this 9th day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty
