John Hoopes of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Seven Dollars and twenty cents to me in hand paid by Massena Taylor of Greenville District and State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Massena Taylor all that Tract a plantation of Land Situated and being in the District and State aforesaid which Tract of Land was surveyed as vacant Land for Elizabeth Will the 16th day of February 1834 Situated in the said District on the waters of Muskrat Creek of S. E. of New River containing 12 Acres more or less the same being within the distance of Five miles of the State Road leading through the Saluda Mountains bounded S. W. & N. W. by Land of Mary Taylor N. E. & E. by Land of James W. Hines and Prince Forester and by the back from marks, Bound as the plot represents Together with all and singular the Rights Members here determined and Appertinancy to the said premises belonging as in any case incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Massena Taylor his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Massena Taylor his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same as any part thereof
