dollars paid by Lewis King & to the said Lewis King bequeathed and released and  
in presents de grant. herein will and release with the said Lewis King all that parcel  
land bounded as follows beginning on a log heap and running Thence S 83 W  
one half Thence S 75 E to a pine tree Thence on known Prasher line a nearly  
thence land corner on said land a nearly corner Thence on Adams land a  
corner on J. P. Smiths land Thence on Smiths land to beginning corner. Being a  
tract of land originally granted to James White bearing date Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> 1801

Together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto in anywise  
in anywise and premises containing One Acre and Forty Nears more or  
less the said Lewis King his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
and assigns and administrators and assigns to warrant and ever defend the above described  
land and premises to the said Lewis King his heirs and assigns forever from myself  
my heirs and from all other persons claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof
