Garrison of the said State and District, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles G. Garrison a certain tract of land containing One hundred and three acres or thereabouts more or less lying in the District North East side of Saluda River and known as the Bridge Street and bounding on lands belonging to Isaac Charles W. Evans, Walter Stewart and others known to said land originally belonging to Charles Garrison son and was sold the first time in July 1845 to satisfy certain executions against Charles Garrison son a purchase by said Alex Acker the title of which land I do hereby warrant and forever defend unto the said Charles G. Garrison his heirs and assigns from myself my heirs and assigns and assigns and administrators unto the said Charles G. Garrison his heirs Executors and Administrators.
