and I do hereby my son West H. Williams of the District of Anderson and State of South Carolina and for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and do bear to my son West H. Williams of the District of Anderson and State of South Carolina and for and in consideration of the good cause and consideration of the said West H. Williams, the following named real and personal estate, To wit: That large body of Land situated in the said District of Greenville, beginning on Saluda River at Elijah Estess line and up the said River to Thomas Hinman's line & thence along the dividing line between myself on the one side and Thomas Hinman, John Charles, Amblett Sullivan, John Jones, Estate of Miss Pined, Jacob Roberts, Samuel Roberts, Henry Woodson, Elijah Estess on the other side to the beginning corner, also an other Tract of Land situated in Anderson District on Camp Creek and containing Six Hundred and ninety six acres (296) being a part of a larger tract containing Six Hundred acres, acquired to me on 23rd June 1844 excluding the Hundred and five acres heretofore divided by me to Sarah Ann Willoughby of the said W. D. Williams also the following named slaves to wit: Peter, the blacksmith and his wife Amy and their five children, Sarah, Alfred, Hilley and Martha also Sarah and Emmetta and their five children, Fanny, Sarah, Susan, Mary-ann and a male baby child name also Reuben, Oliver, Mervin and their two children, Walter and Ansel and also a rather aged Woman slave named Appolona

And it is declared to be the true intent of this deed to give and to convey the fourth, fifth, and ninth clause of my last Will and Testament executed 29th June 1846 and also the second and eighth clause of my codicil executed 19th July 1847 and to convey the entire property therein mentioned and the increase of the said Will a codicil and to leave the said Will and Codicil in full force in all other particulars

So I have and do hereby all and singular the lands and Slaves of the said unto the said West H. Williams his heirs and assigns forever (I do hereby expressly save and reserve to myself the use possession and enjoyment of the entire property aforesaid for and during the term of my natural life And I do hereby warrant and give and defend the property real and personal aforesaid unto the said West H. Williams his heirs and assigns forever and against myself my heirs and assigns all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof
