Susan Barton and Rebecca Barton for the great use and esteem we have for our sister Susan Pantou have given unto the said Susan Pantou a certain parcel or Tract of Land known as the Healdston Beddingfield Tract which tract was bought by John Houghton Esq. deceased in the life time of Healdston Beddingfield and Sintha Beddingfield divided as follows Beginning on a red oak corner Thence N 33 degrees West 23 chains 50 links to a Stake Thence N 26 E 45 chains to a Stake Thence S 43 E 13 chains to a dogwood Stake S 20 E 10 chains to a Stake Thence S 20 W 59 chains to the Beginning Red oak containing one hundred acres more or less and we William Barton and Rebecca Barton do warrant and defend the forenamed lands unto the said Susan Pantou her heirs and assigns forever against ourselves our heirs and assigns or any person a persons claiming the same or any part thereof
