for the Inland District

I, now and men of these premises, that whereas

Born in Mr' Cray, on the 16th day of January

in the year of our Lord 1765 I, heald in writing under his hand as follows
In consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to
be then and paid by Benjamin P. Fenton and Gayle W. Fleming did grant
and sell and release convey unto them Benjamin P. Fenton & Gayle W. Fleming
four hundred and fifty acres more or less bounded as by reference
to a certain plantation tract of land wherein Andrew M. Gray
formerly lived, lying on the waters of Big River in the State and District
aforesaid, containing two hundred acres more or less bounded as by reference
to said and may appear. Now know all ye that, the said Benjamin
Fenton in order to make division and partition of the said tract of Land
between myself and Martin Fleming the widow of Gayle W. Fleming in
consideration of a like conveyance this day executed by Martin Fleming for part
thereof the above described tract have granted, bargained sold and released and
do hereby freely do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Martin Fleming
all my right title interest claim and demands whatsoever of and to all and singular
part of the tract of Land above mentioned, which layeth north of a line beginning
at a rock stone corner running thence 132 W. 7 ch. 82 m. to Hawkins stake
to being a tract of Land granted to John Russell, also all the lands south of a part of a tract
of Land granted to Thomas Fenton, beginning on John Russell's land in a rock corner
and thence bearing 84 degrees 56' 62" to a stake to the opposite side of said tract also all the east end of
a line of land granted to Andrew M. Gray and Juse Davis, as far as the Thomas
all the land granted goes.
