Know all men these presents that I Hugh Bishop of Greenville District and state of South Carolina

for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars to me in hand paid by the Emory united or missionary Baptist church, on the head moneys of Henry Kinner in said district in the state of Georgia, I have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said church and their successors forever a certain lot or parcel of land situated lying and being on the road that leads from Col. Lynchs to Spartanburg six or seven mile east of Bond & Swails beginning on a rock near the road thence West E. 6. 60ths to a stake old line, thence N 6 1/2 W. 2. 18 to a stake or rock, thence S 8 1/2 W. 6. 80 to a hickory and a rock thence N 36 E. 5. 31 to the beginning, containing in or about a half acre more or less together with all and singular the rights (whether hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belong or in any way incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Emory united or missionary Baptist church and their successors for the use of the church and burial ground forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said church and their successors against myself and my heirs and all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the said premises in any part thereof with leave to pass to and from my spring, without my hand and seal this fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three.
