Know all men, these presents that John Paris of the said District of Charleston for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Margaret Paris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey unto the said Margaret Paris, all my under the color of the title in said part of said land fourteen acres of land after one third part has been taken therefrom a certain tract or parcel of land situate on waters of a water river in the said District adjoining lands of William Thomas and Black the tract of land on which said Paris lately deceased resided, containing one hundred and fourteen acres be the same more or less, together with all and singular the rights, manors, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same in anywise belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold the said singular the interest and premises above mentioned unto the said Margaret Paris her heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the interest and premises above mentioned unto the said Margaret Paris her heirs and assigns, against myself, my heirs and assigns and against every person whom I shall lawfully claim the same, or any part thereof.

Witness my hand and seal this fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three and on the twenty eighth year of American Independence.
