 to stake Iron or thence S 50 W 35 1/2 chains to the beginning Decimmon  
 together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appur-  
 tenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appur-  
 taining. Do Give and to Hold all and singular the premises afore-  
 mentioned unto the said William J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever  
 and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators to  
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
 the said William J. Smith his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs  
 against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 and seal this the fifteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
 hundred and forty four and in the beginning of the sixty sixth year of  
 American Independence.
