

Creek waters of Rudy river and part of the original grants the first to Cadwalader Jones the second to Robert Gillson the third to Charles Pope and transferred by diuers conveyances to Edmund B Garrison and by him to David G Garrison

Beginning at a Turkey on the edge of the old field in J I Counters land 38 thence S 28 W 24 chs 15 links to a stake thence S 60 W 9 chs 80 to a stake thence S 28 W 24 chs 15 links to a Stake 38 thence S 50 E 33 chs 30 links to a stake thence N 33 E 37 chs 30 to the Stake <sup>the Stake does</sup> thence continuing the same course to the beginning corner making in all two hundred and thirty seven or less together with all and singular the rights, manors, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident, or appertaining thereto

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said David G Garrison his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend the said premises unto the said David G Garrison his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
