ents that John Russell of this State and District aforesaid have for  
and in consideration of the sum of sixty five Dollars sixty two and a half cents  
to me in hand paid I the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted  
Virginia sold and leased out by these presents do grant Bargain Sell and  
whereby cause and convey unto said Richard H. Pace of this State and  
District before and a tract or parcel of Land containing eight acres and  
three quarters more or less situated lying and being in the District and  
State aforesaid on a Branch of Puck's Creek beginning at a corner in  
Hickman's Holcombe Line running South eighty and a half P. M. to a  
chain and fifty links to a Stake on Lee's Hick's Creek South  
fifty three West Trinity chain bearing links to a Black Gum on  
Holcombes Line a conditional Line made by the said John Russell and  
Richard H. Pace thence S. twenty seven west with Holcombes Line running  
thence to the beginning it being part of a tract of Land granted to  
Thomas Banton.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, inhabitants and  
possessories to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said Richard H. Pace his heirs and assigns forever and  
I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators for  
warrant and command I do all and singular the said premises unto  
the said Richard H. Pace his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs  
and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
