The Indenture Made the second

of January in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty  
five between Samuel A. James Esquire Commissioner of the Humble Court  
of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said State  
of the one part and Odam Cox of the other part.

Whereas Sir McCoy and Johnstone McCoy by attorney of the  
said next parties did on a about the Twenty seventh day of September in the year  
of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five filed in this office their  
Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the  
State against Susan Cox and others praying for partition of the Real Estate  
of John Cox deceased.

And the cause being before the Honorable  
Court come on to be heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and fifty five the 1<sup>st</sup> December last a parcel of land  
therein more particularly described there to be sold at Public Auction by  
the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes men-  
tioned in their several order as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said  
Court will appear. And the said Samuel A. James as the Commissioner  
of the said Court after having duly advertised the said <sup>to</sup> parcel of land  
for sale by Public Auction on the second day of January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four did then openly and pub-  
licly and according to the custom of such a sale and dispose of the said land  
before described unto the said Odam Cox for the sum of three thousand and  
one dollars the being at that price the highest bidder for the same.

Now Therefore This Indenture Witnesseth That the said  
Samuel A. James as Commissioner of the said Court under  
and by virtue of the said Deed and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand  
and twenty one dollars paid by him the said Odam Cox the Receipt where  
of he doth acknowledge, hath Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by the  
said Presents doth Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Odam Cox  
of his place and assigns all that certain <sup>not</sup> parcel of Land lying and being  
situate in the said State and District known and described as follows by a survey  
and plan thereof made by John C. Hough R. S. that is to say Beginning by an  
end at a Stake or Thence S 86° 45' 50" to a P. C. 37' Thence S 83° W 30' Rock 37' then  
S 34 E 13° 50' Rock gate 37' thence N 15° E 37' 54' Spanish Oak 60' gone 37'  
frontiers, thence S 49 E 13° 50' R. 0. 37' thence North 21. 50' chuse 37' thence
