I have and to hold all and singular the premises by force mentioned to Joseph and William Barton their heirs and affins thence and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to no man and forever to hold singular the said premises unto the said Joseph and William Barton or their heirs and affins against all suits of any kind and again I say that I do renounce all my rights and immunitiess and affinities to the said premises or premises whomsoever lawfully claiming over to claim them same or any part thereof.
