This indenture made the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty. Between Pleasant Klop and his wife Mary Klop of the State & District aforesaid of the one part and W. A. Mooney of the same State & District of the other part. Witnesseth that the said P. Klop & wife Mary Klop for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars lawful money to them in hand paid by the said W. A. Mooney at or before the enrolling & delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold released conveyed & confirmed & by these presents do grant bargained sold alien remise release convey & confirm unto the said W. A. Mooney his heirs & assigns forever all that parcel of land lying and being in Greenville District & State aforesaid it being the land whereon we now live & also the land whereon Jacob Sand lives beginning on a Pine of R. Bowden & on the old Loggole Road & running with with S^d Road, of R. Bowden line, to a black oak & said old Road thence with S^d W. A. Mooney's line to a B. O. thence S 43. W 11° to a stake at the branch thence with the Branch to R. O. the old Hardin corner now of Barnets & thence E 11° to B. O. thence N 60 E 12° to a W. O. thence S 15 to the beginning corner, containing one hundred & eighteen acres more or less. The above land is bounded by lands of J. R. Bowden James Barnett W. A. Mooney & others together with all & singular the tenements hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rents issues profits thereof & also all the estate right title interest power & right of dower, property possession claim & demand, whatsoever as well in law as in Equity of the said parties of the first part of us & to the same & every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances. To have and to hold the above granted bargained & described premises with the appurtenances unto the said W. A. Mooney his heirs & assigns to his & their own proper use benefit forever

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
