 To For Know all Men by these presents
 Newton Babb Land That we Jane Gault and John
 Gault of Greenville District in
 the aforesaid State in consideration of Three Hundred
 and Sixty two Dollars to us paid by Newton Babb of
 Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted
 bargained sold and released and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said Newton
 Babb a small piece of land containing ninety and one
 half acres situated in District aforesaid known as the
 Childers Tract beginning on a white oak near the Road
 and running thence along the road N 13 E 41.50 through
 field to white oak 34 thence S 57 W 62.26 to Stone 34 thence
 S 81 E 43.80 to the beginning. Together with all and singu-
 lar the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Newton Babb
 his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind
 our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
 the said Newton Babb his heirs and assigns against
 us and our heirs and against every other person
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof. Witness our hands and seals this 15th day
 of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and 61 and in the year of the
 Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America
