Know all men by these presents that we John Gault and Newton Babb and his wife E A Babb of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Nineteen hundred and Forty dollars to us paid by Jane Gault of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jane Gault all that tract of land known as the home tract of James Gault Decr containing Two hundred and Forty two and a half acres (242 1/2) Situated in the District aforesaid beginning on a pin N 62 W 8.60 thence N 21 1/2 E 32.50 to Spanish oak bounded by J L Westmorelands thence N 88 W 67.60 to State 158 W 10 to Stone thence S 46 1/2 E 37.50 S 38 E 19 S 60 E 24 50 bounded by J K Stone to Pine thence N 29 E 24 bounded by R Bryson to Pine the beginning corner

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jane Gault her heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jane Gault her heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and against every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
