 To Leonard Williams Lot For Greenville
 Know all men by these that I John Westfield of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty One Hundred dollars to me paid by Leonard Williams. Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain sold and release and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Leonard Williams all that house & lot of Land on which Gen W H Casby lived last year lying on the Eastern Side of the Augusta Road within the incorporation of of the Town of Greenville beginning on Logan Clinch corner on the Augusta Road and running thence N 27 E 165 ft to James Flicks corner thence S 64 1/2 E 330 ft to T McBees line thence S 14 W 40 ft 3 in to an angle on said line thence S 36 W 132 ft on said line to said Logan Clinch corner thence along said Logan Clinch line N 64 W 320 ft to the beginning corner containing one Acre and Twenty Two Perches more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Leonard Williams his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever all and singular the said premises unto the said Leonard Williams his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and assigns and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the Eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty and in the 84th year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
