To Have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Rebecca Davis her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said her the said Rebecca Davis her heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and also against any and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
