appoint one or more substitutes under him and
the same to revoke at pleasure and generally to
do and perform all such acts matters and things
as my said attorney for the completion and effectual
execution of the authority herein before granted as fully
as I might and could do if I were personally present
hereby ratifying and confirming all the acts of
my said Attorney or his substitutes done by virtue
and in pursuance of these presents.
