South Carolina } Greenville District } Know all men by these presents that I James H Stokes of the above State and District in consideration of Two thousand Dollars to me paid by J L Stokes of the above State and District have granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto to the said J L Stokes a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville District and the State aforesaid on the waters of Woods Creek, Beginning at a Black Jack + corner known by the name of Goodwin Old Survey thence along said S 15 E 80 50 to black oak Cox thence N 74 E 55.30 to a stake corner thence N 2 1/2 W 49.00 to Hickory x 3 thence N 65 W 35.00 to a black Jack x 3 thence W 35.00 to the beginning " Together with all and singular the rights the members hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J L Stokes his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my self and my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J L Stokes his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one and in the Eighty fifth year of the Independence of the United States Signed Sealed and delivered In presence of Joseph Cooper Hugh Bushop J H Stokes
