 unto the said John Gosnell a certain tract or

 aforesaid on both sides of a branch of Beaverdam
 Creek Waters of North Saluda River known as
 the Hamilton Beddingfield tract and bounded as
 follows. Beginning on a red oak corner thence N 35
 W 23.50 chs to a stake 3+ thence N 26 E 45 chs to a stake
 3+ thence N 73 E 13 chs to a dogwood 3+ thence S 20 E 10 chs
 to a stake 3+ thence N 20 1/2 W 59 00 chs to a red oak
 the beginning corner containing one hundred acres
 more or less adjoining lands belonging to Rebecca
 Barton and others. Together with all and
