aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five
 thousand Dollars to me paid by J. C. Hicks of Greenville
 District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said J. C. Hicks his heirs Executors
 and administrators, All that Tract of land situate lying
 and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid
 on the waters of Saluda River beginning at a stone corner
 and running South 53 East 69 chains to a dead pine
 corner thence North 34 E 27 chs. 12 links to a red oak
 corner thence N 52 W 20.50 links to a red oak thence N 32
 W 36.50 to a small black oak thence South 54 W 43.50 to the
 beginning, containing Two Hundred Acres more or less being
 the same Tract of Land purchased by me from Mrs Mary
 Pountell by deed bearing date the 24th day of May
 1853 and recorded in Register Meane Conveyance Book
 W. Page 624 & 625. Together with all and singular the Rights
 Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
 ises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said J. C. Hicks his heirs and assigns forever.
 and I do hereby bind my self and my heirs executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said J. C. Hicks his heirs and assigns
 against me and my heirs and all persons lawfully claiming or
 to claim the same or any part thereof

 the year of our Lord One thousand eight Hundred and sixty one
 and in the 86th year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the
