I know all men by these presents
that I M O Oshields of Spartanburg

District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of
Two hundred Dollars to me paid by James Moss of Greenville
District in the State aforesaid have granted Bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain
sell and release unto the Said James Moss all that tract
or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville District
on Branches of Lamison Mill Creek waters of South Pac-
-olet River being part of a tract of land originally granted
to Nathaniel Gentry on 9th Jan 1793, beginning at a black
oak corner down on the west side of a branch near the
Hatters Shop Running thence S56° West 10.15 to a Chestnut & newel
thence N23° W43.80 to a slate & new on the Gentry grant line
in the bottom of a deep hollow near its head thence N79½ E
along said grant line S70° E 29 chains to a Spanish oak near
the place of Cookess P.O corner gone thence S36° W 23 to the
beginning corner containing one hundred and three acres be the
same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the Said James Moss his heirs and assigns for ever, and
I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the Said James Moss his heirs and assigns
against my self my heirs and against ever other person or persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof. Witness my hand seal this 12th day of March AD 1862
