and District aforesaid for an inconsideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars to us in hand paid by William B Lindsey of the District of Pickens and State aforesaid the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William B Lindsey all that tract or parcel of Land situate in the State and District aforesaid and lying on South Saluda River containing One Hundred and twenty Acres be the same more or less Beginning at the River on a water oak thence Running N 51 E 2 chains and 21 links to a Rock thence N 37 W 5 chains to Rock thence N 52 E 5 chains and 38 links to Post oak thence S 88 E 5 chains and 25 links to Post Oak thence N 87 E 7 chains and 50 links to a Pine thence N 67 E 9 chains to Red oak thence N 20 E 10 chains to Red oak thence N 51 W 21 chains and 25 links to a Rock on the river thence down the meanders of the river to the beginning white oak Together with all and and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said W^m B Lindsey his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind our selves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W^m B Lindsey & his heirs against our selves our heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
