 deceased to where John Anderson lives thence N 37 W 18.80
 to a stone thence N 39 W 32.50 to a stone 3+ thence S 52 W 31.75
 to a stone 3+ thence N 40 W 14.10 to a stone 3+ thence S 52 W 18.20
 to a stone 3+ thence S 40 E 46.36 to a stake 3+ thence N 53 E 28.50
