

Benson by William McGoodlett a small portion by Cox & Gower to Said James Mc Benson including about one fourth of an acre on the same side of the Augusta Road adjoining the rail road tract and separated from the main lot by a small street the said lot on which a brick dwelling is situated is bounded on the south by lands of J W Brooks west by D G Westfield East by the Augusta road commencing on a Stake on the said road south of the house & running thence S 60 W 4° 34' to a Stake thence N 14 W 5° 20' to a Stake, thence N 62 E 4° 34' to a Stake on the Augusta road thence along said road to the begining corner. The other portion conveyed includes all the lands in the angle between the Street, Augusta road and the rail road line of which there is no plot the whole including all the lots owned by the said Willis Benson and James Mc Benson in the town of Greenville on the west side of the Augusta Road. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John H Lopez his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind our selves and our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John H Lopez his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs & all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
