Saving and excepting two lots each of 118 by 128 feet, sold and conveyed by me respectively to J A David and to Miss Griffith from the southern end of said square. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Mr Sarah P Allen her heirs and assigns forever and I hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs Sarah P Allen her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof -- Witness my hand and seal this thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two, and in the eighty sixth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the State of South Carolina."
