gained sold and released and by these presents do grant her-  
gain sell and release unto the said Julius C Smith all that  
certain piece parcel and Lot of Land situate lying and being  
in Village of Greenville in the State aforesaid adjoining the  
Lot of Harry Glenn and lot of Joseph Powell begining on a  
rock corner of said Glenns lot a long said street forty seven  
feet more or less to fence joining portico of Powells house  
thence in a direct line a croft said Lot three hundred feet  
to a street next to S D Goodlitts thence down said street forty  
seven feet more or less to a rock corner on Glenns line thence  
along said line three hundred feet to the begining corner con-  
taining one half acre more or less also ten feet front running  
back to the original back corner being a small piece purchased  
by me from Harry Glenn the first lot was deeded to me by  
J Powell his deed recorded in registers registers mesne conveyance
