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The State of South Carolina know all men by these presents that I John S McDaniel of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Thirteen Hundred Dollars to me paid by Julius C Smith of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Julius C Smith all that certain piece parcel and Lot of Land situate lying and being in Village of Greenville in the State aforesaid adjoining the Lot of Harry Glenn and lot of Joseph Powell beginning on a rock corner of said Glenns lot a long said Street forty seven feet more or less to fence joining, portico, of Powells house thence in a direct line a crop said Lot three hundred feet to a street next to S D Goodlets; thence down said Street forty seven feet more or less to a rock corner on Glenns line thence along said line three hundred feet to the beginning corner, containing one half acre more or less. also Ten feet front running back to the original back corner being a small piece purchased by me from Harry Glenn the first lot was deeded to me by J Powell see deed recorded in registers Messrs Courtyaues Book X Page 207. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Julius C Smith his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Julius C Smith his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against all other persons whomsoever lawfully
