District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Seven hundred Dollars to me paid by Louisa A Moise of the city of Charleston in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Louisa A Moise of the City of Charleston all that Lot piece or parcel of land lying and being within the corporate limits of the town of Greenville in the State aforesaid beginning at a stake on Pendleton Street and running S 20 1/2 E 406 feet to a stake on the side of a Street Thence with said Street N 26 1/2 E 152 feet to a stake on the side of a Street N 20 3/4 W 304 to a stake on the Pendleton Street. Thence with Pendleton Street S 68 1/4 W 102 feet to the beginning containing Three Rods and Seventeen Perches more or less as may be more fully represented by a plat of the same Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Louisa A Moise her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Louisa A Moise her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this Fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two and in the Eighty Sixth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the South Carolina
