parties of the first part and J. J. Chesolm Surgeon and Medical  
Purveyor Confederate States Army at Columbia party of the  
second part Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part  
have bargained and agreed and do hereby bargain and agree  
to Manufacture and deliver to the said J. J. Chesolm Surg &  
Medical Purveyor C. S. Army at the Medical Purveyor's Depot  
or at Greenville Four thousand Gallons of Whiskey of Fifty  
per cent proof quality at the price of One dollar and Twenty  
five cents per Gallon payable at the completion of the contract  
and subject to the following terms and conditions. To wit, the  
said Whiskey to be delivered as above at the rate of Two thousand  
Gallons per Week until the whole quantity is delivered, commencing  
on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1862 to be of pure proof quality, the  
Government reserving to itself the absolute right to determine as  
to the said quality purity and proof of said Whiskey which is to  
be put up Security in new tight and durable Barrels as a  
precaution against Leakage and evaporation, the said  
parties of the first part, do further obligate themselves, not to  
make or sell any other party or parties, Whomsoever any Whis-  
key or other products of their Distillery until this contract  
has been fully and faithfully executed in all its parts, but  
that the said Distillery shall be used exclusively for the  
proper and prompt performance of this agreement. It is  
further agreed that the said J. J. Chesolm Surg. & Med Purveyor  
C. S. Army party of the second part reserves to the Department  
which he represents the privilege of selecting and employing  
for the Government an agent to reside at or near the Distillery  
of said parties of the first part whose duty it shall be to see  
that the terms and conditions of this contract be duly perf-  
ormed and the interest of the Government protected, so insure  
the due and faithful performance of this contract, the said  
parties of the first part have this day entered into a Bond  
with approved security, with conditions annexed thereto,  
for the sum of three thousand Dollars which said Bond with
