 Know all men by these presents

that I Israel Charles of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the natural love and affection I bear to my Sister Francis Mosteller of the county of Hall and State of Georgia do hereby give unto Henry Mosteller a negro woman named Mariah and her child Hobbit and their increase in Trust for the sole separate and Exclusive use of my said Sister Francis Mosteller and it is my wish that the said negroes and their increase should remain with my said Sister during her natural life free from all liabilities on account of any debts or contracts of her present or any future husband, with remainder over to her children living at the time of her death or to their representatives or if after the death of my said Sister it shall seem desirable to sell the said negroes, the said Henry Mosteller shall do so and the proceeds arising from said sale, shall be equally divided amongst the children of my said Sister or amongst their representatives.
