we Joseph Green and Catharine Benson

of the State & District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to us in hand paid by America Fowler of the same State & District. We have granted bargained sold & released unto the said America Fowler all that tract or parcel of land containing One hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying on both sides of Enoree River begining on a pine on the north side of said river near the head of the Mill Pond thence \$5.50 to the River S 2. chains to a stake on Gilbreath line at the corner of the Jackson Grove Camp ground thence N 83 $\frac{1}{4}$  E to Stake thence S 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 8 to a Stake thence to a pine thence S 84 E 6.30 to a Red oak on said Gilbreath line thence N 56 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 14 to a maple on the bank of S. river thence down the meanders of said River to a Stake thence croping the river runing N 65 E to a Red oak bush 3+ on said Gilbreaths line thence N 14 W 25.80 to a Spanish oak 3+ thence N 80 W 33.57 to the begining. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertaining to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all singular the premises before mentioned unto the said America Fowler his heirs and against our selves and our heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
