

Thos A Walker To Archibald Vaughn	Deed For Land	South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I Thomas A Walker of the District & State aforesaid for an in consideration of twelve hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Archibald Vaughn have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Archibald Vaughn a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the State and District aforesaid, beginning at a Stake running S 62 West 11 c to a rock. thence N 66 W 21.50 to a Stake or stone, thence S 6 E 39.50 to a Rock on a Road thence N 75 E 36 to Stake thence N 20 1/2 W 38 to the beginning Stake containing one hundred acres more or less bounded by lands of Pinckney Vaughn Thomas Atkinson and part of Bramlett and half acre on the original tract being part of a tract of land that said Thos Walker purchased of James Lock. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Archibald Vaughn his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby do bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the aforesaid premises unto the said Archibald Vaughn his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this Nov 10 th 1862 Signed sealed and delivered in presence of 3 Thos A Walker Wm P Vaughn L 73 Austin 3
