

in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of One Hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by George W Bruce of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargain and sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George W Bruce all that tract or parcel of land lying & being in Greenville District and State of So. Carolina containing One hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning on a Post Oak near Rawsons Creek and running near a west course to a stake on the Jordan Road thence binding on the road to a stake thence on East course to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises herebefore mentioned unto the said George W Bruce his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises unto the said George W Bruce his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this twentieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight and in the Seventy third year of the Independence of the United States of America, signed sealed and delivered in the presence
