Know all men by these presents
 that I Richard Underwood in consideration of the love and
 affection which I have & bear for my daughter Matilda Nix
 as well as in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to
 me paid do hereby acknowledge & declare that I hold a certain
 tract of land situate in the District of Greenville aforesaid
 on waters of Mush Creek. known as the John Boswell place
 containing two hundred & fifty acres more or less bounded
 by lands of H A Miles A S Neaves & J L Children & others it
 being the tract whereon said Matilda Nix now resides. In
 Trust for the sole separate & exclusive use of the said Matilda
 Nix during her life free from all debts contracts or liabilities
 of her present or any future husband during her life & after
 her death in trust for her children living at her death to them
 & their heirs forever the issue of any deceased child to take
 the portion or interest in said land that the parent would
 do if living & in trust that during the life time of the said
 Matilda she shall have recourse use & enjoy to her separate
 use free from all contracts debts or liabilities of any husband
 she may have the rents issues & profits of said land and I
 do further declare that I hold the said land on the further
 trust & power reserved on my part to appoint another trustee
 by deed or will in my place room & stead. To hold the said lands
 on the same trusts as above set forth and I do hereby bind my
 self my heirs executors & administrators by these presents in the
 premises to fulfil and carry out the trust & declaration afore
 said in behalf of my said daughter during her life & to her
 children after her death & issue then living. In testimony whereof

 forever, being first interlined this the Twelfth day of January 1863
