Thomas for said George W. Collins in the State aforesaid and by and with the consent and instruction of said George W. Collins have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George W. Collins and his heirs all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville District of this State on waters of Needy River adjoining lands of A. Norton on the North & McCre on the East C & W Parkins on the South and W. Sapp on the West containing three hundred and sixty six acres more or less and having such meets and bounds as formerly belonged to it as the land of Hugh Stokes Esquire of Greenville District Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George W. Collins and his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
