Know all men by these presents that we Alfred Turner and Arrena Turner his wife of Greenville District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of three hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Katharine Hudgens of the District and State above specified have granted bargained sold & released unto by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Katharine Hudgens all our right title & interest to & in a certain tract of land or parcel of land lying & being in said District on the waters of Mush Creek bounded by lands of James McKenny Mrs Cox & James Jackson part of a tract of land owned by John Miller deceased. Supposed to be about thirty seven acres more or less this instrument is intended to convey all our interest in the said premises to the said Katharine Hudgens her heirs & assigns forever together with all & singular all our right title & claim to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same against our selves our heirs & assigns unto the said Katharine Hudgens her heirs & assigns forever. Witness our hands & seals this 7th day of February A.D. 1863.

To E. S. Buist	For Lot	Greenville District

Know all men by these presents that I Vardry M. Bee of the Village of Greenville State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and forty six dollars twenty five cents to me paid by E. S. Buist of the same State and District have this day granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said E. S. Buist a certain piece parcel or tract of land situated and being about two and a half miles from Greenville Village on waters of Brusck Creek and bounded as follows. To wit Beginning on a Black Jack corner of Sam Mauldin's, and runs thence crossing Brushy Creek South 18° 18' chs 25 links with Townes line to a Stake thence South 72° 10' chs 40 links to a Stake
