The State of South Carolina

Whenas on the eleventh day  
of September in the year of

our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one Lewis  
S Thruston made his last will and testament at Greenville  
Court House in the District and State aforesaid, in which  
the following clauses occurs. In the first place my will is  
and I direct that my whole estate of what nature whatsoever  
it may be real personal and mixed be equally divided between  
my wife Henrietta R Thruston and my two children Richard  
and Lelia Thruston Shan and Shan alike and in case either  
of my said children should die before arriving to full age  
and without issue then and in that case his or her portion  
is to be equally divided between their mother and the surviving  
child Shan and Shan alike. In the next place I nominate  
constitute and appoint my brother Henry L Thruston  
Executor of this my last will and testament. The said  
Lewis S Thruston having departed this life the aforesaid  
last will and testament was admitted to probate and  
the Executor therein named duly qualified thereon, upon the  
20<sup>th</sup> day of September AD 1854 before L Mc Bee Esquire ordinary  
of Greenville District. In December of the same year Lelia  
Thruston the daughter of Lewis S Thruston then an infant  
died leaving Richard Thruston as the surviving child, by  
which event the whole estate became divisible between the  
aforesaid Henrietta R Thruston and the said Richard  
Thruston Shan and Shan alike. The Executor H Lee  
Thruston proceeded to execute the will and and his return  
for the year 1855. 1856. 1857. 1858 1859 and 1860 are duly  
filed and recorded in the office of the ordinary for  
Greenville District. In February of 1860 the said executor  
himself died at Greenville Court House in the said State  
leaving, by his last will and testament duly recorded  
in the office of the ordinary of Greenville District. Susan  
W Thruston and Robert S Thruston Executors and Executors  
of his said last will and testament, upon which they have  
duly qualified and proved the same in common form.  
By virtue of these facts therefore the aforesaid Susan W  
Thruston and Robert S Thruston have become the Executrix  
and Executor of the will of the aforesaid Lewis S Thruston  
deceased. In the latter part of the year 1856 the aforesaid  
Henrietta R Thruston widow of Lewis S Thruston deceased  
intermarried with Alexander Mc Bee of Greenville District  
in the State aforesaid, and in as much as the estate of the  
said Lewis S Thruston was all of a personal nature, the  
said Alexander Mc Bee become entitled by virtue of his marital  
rights to the Shan of the said Henrietta in the said Estate  
of Lewis S Thruston deceased. In the month of February  
AD 1862 Susan W Thruston was appointed guardian by an  
order of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District
