To Greenville District  
James A McCarter For Land Know all men by these presents  
that I Jane S Butter of the District  
of State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and  
thirty seven dollars & fifty cents to me paid by James A McCarter  
of the same State & District have granted bargained sold & released  
by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said  
James A McCarter all that tract or parcel of land situated  
in the district of Greenville aforesaid ~~containing~~ at a Stake  
corner on the northern side of a road which runs between  
the tract & lands of Wm Lowndes running thence N $16\frac{1}{2}$  E $5.75$  to a  
Stone & thence S $75\frac{1}{2}$  E $29$  ch crooping a branch to a Stone & thence  
N $11\frac{3}{4}$  E $11$  to a Stake & thence N $76\frac{1}{4}$  W $4.05$  to a white oak & thence  
N $10$  E $3.60$  to a Stone & crooping branch thence N $78.2$  W $13.90$  to a Stake  
& crooping branch not far from the corner thence S $10.2$  W $3.60$  to a  
red oak & thence N $77$  W $16$  to a stone & formerly P. Oak gone thence  
S $2$  W $11.10$  to a red oak & dead on the south side of the road thence  
along said road a south Eastern course to the begining corner  
bounded South by land of Wm Lowndes Thomas A Lowndes East by  
Wilson's land North by Martin's lands N West by McCarter's lands  
according to the description & plat of the same in a Survey made  
by James H Dickson 1<sup>st</sup> August 5, 1857, as will more fully ap-  
pear by reference to the said Survey. Together with all & singular  
the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said James A McCarter his heirs and  
assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs & executors  
administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said  
premises unto the said James A McCarter his heirs & assigns -  
against me & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof."
